Thank you for requesting the comments of the Division for Historic Preservation of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) as part of your SEQRA process. These comments are those of OPRHP and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include potential environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project. Such impacts must be considered as part of the environmental review of the project pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617).

We note that the proposed utility pole installation site is located adjacent to the Gomez Mill House, which is listed in the State and National Registers of Historic Places.

We have reviewed the submission received on 7/7/2017. We understand that the proposed installation falls under Section III.E of the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement for Review of Effects on Historic Properties for Certain Undertakings Approved by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC 04-222). If the lead agency concludes that additional studies would be beneficial to identify and/or assess potential impacts upon historic resources, the OPRHP would be pleased to provide additional guidance. However, based upon the provided information, it does not appear that we would be concerned with the proposed installation with regard to the impact on historic resources.
