The following information is submitted to the Town of Marlborough Planning Board for review and consideration in connection with the application of Brooklyn Bottling Company and are in response to the comments received from McGoey, Hauser and Edsall Consulting Engineers, D.P.C. dated May 28, 2019 and June 26, 2019:

May 28, 2019:

1. The applicant engaged Albany Fire Protection, Inc. to perform the Hydrant Flow Test at the site, a copy of which is included in this submission. The applicant has requested additional information including a proposed fire protection plan supported by an engineering report. This will be forwarded to the Town of Marlborough when completed.
2. The grading and utility plan has been revised to include the location and planting schedule for the three proposed flow thru stormwater planters.
3. The New York State Department of Conservation stormwater planter detail has been added to the Site Details sheet SD-1, including all dimensions.
4. Enclosed with this submission is the detail of the proposed on building LED wall pack with zero uplight in accordance with Ulster County Planning Board dark sky recommendations.
5. Submission was made to the Ulster County Planning Board for consideration at their July 03, 2019 meeting.
