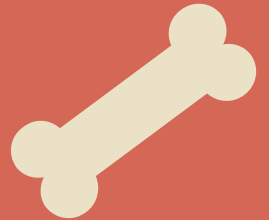




# Paws At Play

bland.

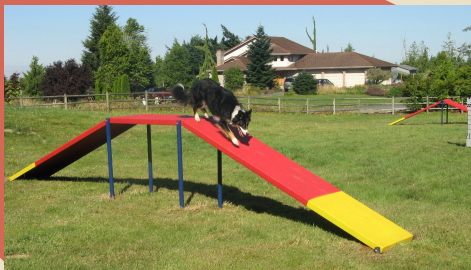
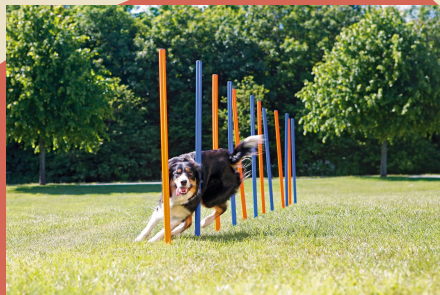




# Agility Equipment



# These 3 equipment pieces were chosen because they are interactive and usable by dogs of all skill levels

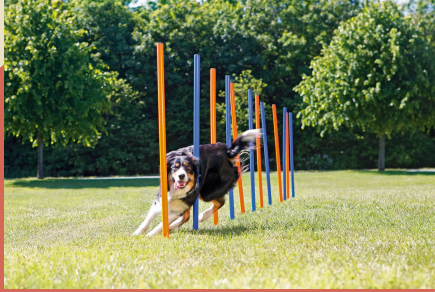
