

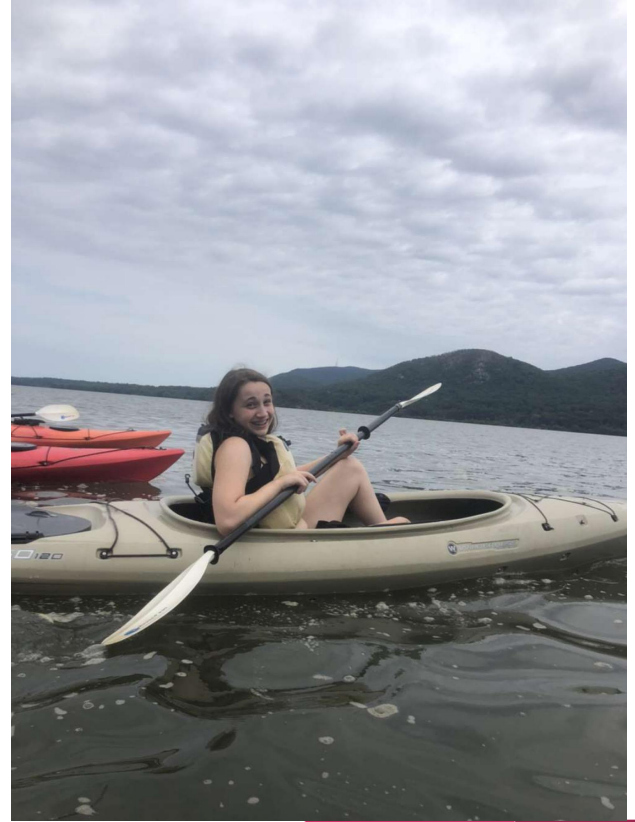


Doggone Fun

Why?

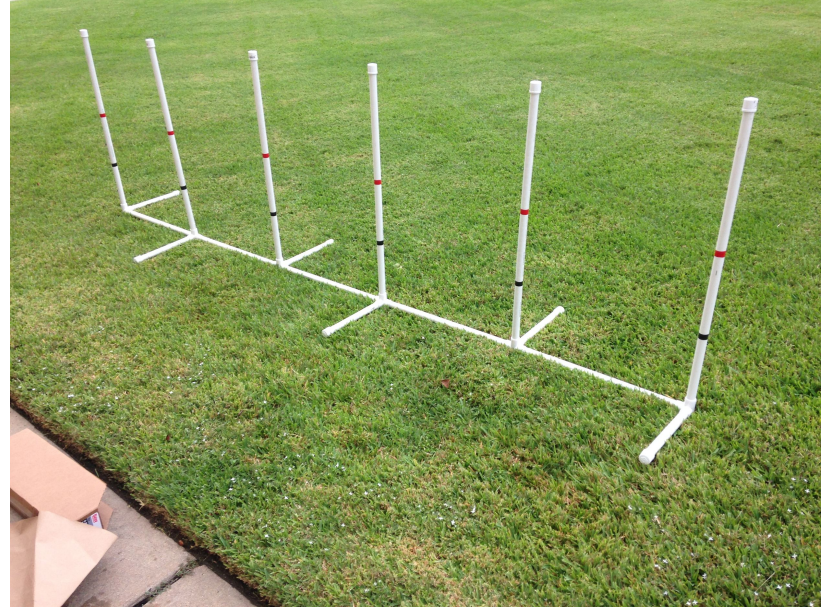
- ★ More to Do

 - During this pandemic, a lot is closed. What better way to spend time than to spend it becoming best friends with you dog?



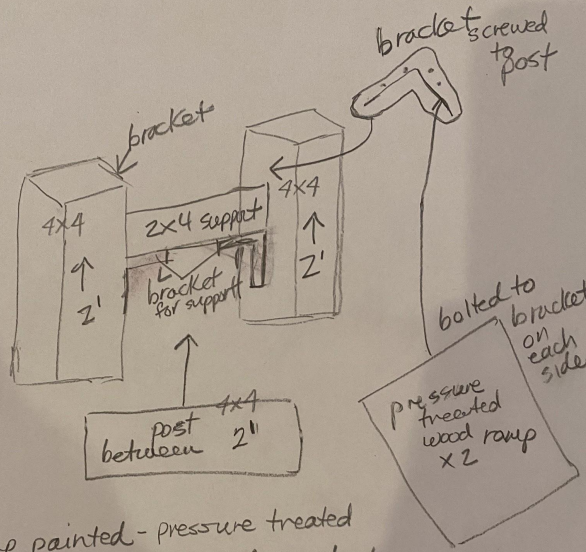

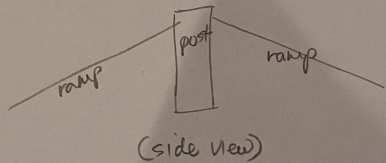
Equipment Inspiration



RAMP

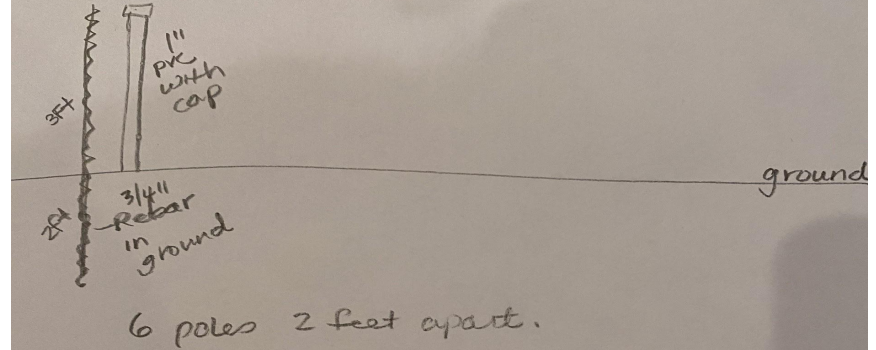


- 1- ramp painted - pressure treated
