B). Resolution # 72 To award the dichlorination bid for the Milton Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Whereas, the NYSDEC has mandated certain improvements to be made at the Milton Wastewater Treatment Facility, Milton Sewer District in the Hamlet of Milton; and

Whereas Plans and Specifications for the improvements have been prepared by Brinnier and Larios, P.C., Professional Engineers, of Kingston, NY; and

Whereas, said Plans and Specifications have been approved by the NYSDEC Region 3 office; and

Whereas, the project was publicly bid and seven(7) bids were received on September 22, 2021; and

Whereas, the lowest responsible bidder is Wittcon, Inc. Of Thompson Ridge, NY with a low bid of \$67,000.00. and a recommendation of award has been made by the project engineers.

Therefore Be It Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Marlborough awards this contract to Wittcon, Inc. Of Thompson Ridge, NY in the amount of \$67,000.00 and authorizes the supervisor to enter into a contract with Wittcon, Inc. for this work at the Milton Wastewater Treatment Facility.
