"Outstanding Resident of the Year" Award

The Outstanding Resident of the Year Award is a newly implemented award given by the Town Board of Marlborough for any outstanding person residing in our community. Those interested in nominating a resident for this award should submit up to a 500 word essay describing an individual who exemplifies the following characteristics:

- They make a positive impact on the community
- They demonstrate good character and the willingness to help others in the community

Nominees need to be:

- A resident of Marlborough for at least 10 years
- At least 18 years of age

An elected official currently in office in the Town of Marlborough is NOT eligible for nomination.

The Marlborough Town Board will review all nominee essays and will select a candidate based on the Town's spirit of volunteerism and community service.

The winning candidate will be presented with an "Outstanding Resident of the Year" Plaque and their name and the names of all future winners will be on display on a plaque in the board room.

The deadline for submission of essays is November 22, 2024. Please submit essays to the Town Clerks Office.
