

TOWN OF MARLBOROUGH NOTICE OF DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST

In accordance with the Town of Marlborough Code of Ethics, Article 13-3 (E) and Public Officers Law § 209, the following disclosure notice ("notice") must be completed and signed by any individual, including any officer or employee of the Town of Marlborough, who has an application, petition or request submitted for a variance, amendment, change of zoning, approval of a plat, special use permit, site plan, subdivision, exemption from a plat or official map, license or permit, pursuant to the provisions of the zoning and planning regulations of the Town of Marlborough before any Town of Marlborough Board, Agency or Department ("decision-making authority"), in which a Town officer or employee has an interest in the subject of the application. The purpose of the disclosure notice is to identify and disclose any potential or actual conflict of interest for the Town employee or officer, which may compromise his/her ability to make decisions solely in the public interest. Please refer to the Town of Marlborough Code of Ethics for further information.

Under the Town of Marlborough Code of Ethics an interest is defined as: a participation, connection or involvement of any sort whether direct or indirect, pecuniary or non-pecuniary, personal or professional, which may result in a benefit. For the purposes of the Town of Marlborough Code of Ethics, the "interests" of a Town officer or employee shall be deemed to include the "interest" of:

- A. An immediate family member. Immediate family member is defined as: grand parents, parents, spouse, significant other, children, grand children, brother, sister, dependent, or any household member of a Town officer, Town Board member or employee.
- B. Any person other than a bank, trust company or other lending institution with whom he/she has a substantial debtor-creditor or other financial relationship.
- C. Any person by whom he/she is employed or of which he/she is an officer, director or member having a controlling interest in any business or enterprise in which the Town employee or officer holds stock or has any other profit-bearing or beneficial relationship.
- D. An officer or employee shall also be deemed to have an interest in a matter if he/she or any person described in A through C above is a party to an agreement, expressed or implied, with any applicant before any Board of the Town, whereby he/she may receive any payment or other benefit whether or not for services rendered, dependent or contingent upon the favorable approval of any such application, petition or request by any Town body.






