Good Afternoon Rosanne, Mike, and Emerson,

I am writing as a follow up to our conversation back in October regarding the bus pickup for the proposed project at Dock Road (Orchards on Hudson). I have attached our Site Plan as a reminder of the project.

We relayed the takeaways from our conversation with you to the Marlborough Planning Board and they have asked for written confirmation of what we discussed. I have included my notes from our phone conversation in bulleted form below. Can you please confirm this represents your feedback to our team, or if you prefer, we welcome a letter from your team with your feedback to share with the Planning Board.

Notes from Discussion with Marlboro Schools on 4/17 at 1:00pm

VHB and Marlboro Central Schools

- The access road to the proposed development off of Route 9W is a private road, and public school busses are not permitted to enter onto private roadways
- Therefore, bus pickup for school children within the proposed development will need to occur along Route 9W
- Bus pickup will occur as long as there is at least one student within the proposed development
- A waiting area should be provided and set back from Route 9W to allow for safe gathering and pickup
